

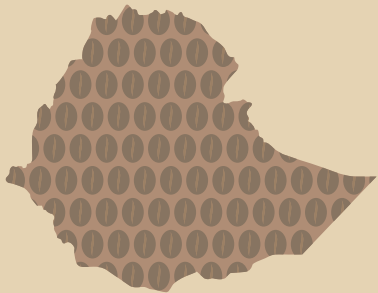
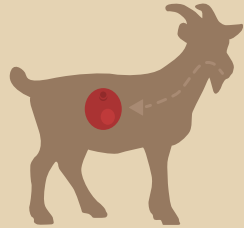

Product from Indonesia

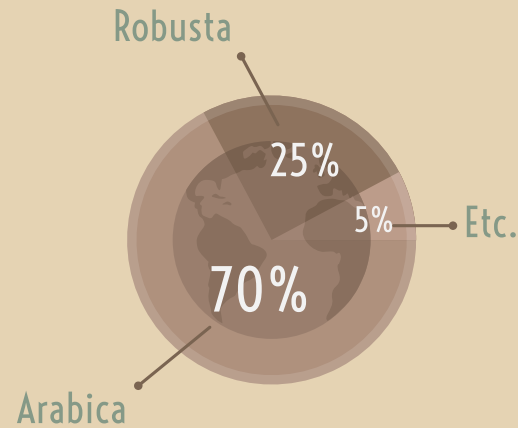
- "KOPI LUWAK" is Indonesia coffee. palm civet that eaten coffee beans and then excreted.

- "BLACK IVORY" is Thai coffee. elephant that eaten coffee beans and then excreted [like palm civet]



Arabica

- Planted at about 3,000 feet above sea level yield basis. Aromatic flavor The Arabica coffee beans contain less caffeine than Robusta varieties of coffee worldwide, about 1 times the yield varieties of Arabica coffee is 70%.

Robusta

- Grown in areas above sea level, not so much. Mostly grown in tropical countries. A taste Pungent aroma of Arabica coffee varieties. Accounted for 25% of global coffee production.
